

# ADAPTER PACK A - Finials with a post

NOTE: These instructions are for finials with a post that use ADAPTER PACK (A). If your finial is a hollow slide-on type, please see the reverse side of these instructions.




Place brackets against wall at desired locations.

Mark screw holes with pencil. Be sure marks are level across opening. Mount at least one bracket on each inner rod and outer rod to prevent rod




If screws are going directly into wood trim or wall stubs, drill a 1/8" pilot hole at pencil marks. If screwing into drywall, follow drywall anchor instruction at the bottom of the page.



■ ASSEMBLE ROD

Assemble the rod by inserting and sliding the smaller diameter rod into the larger diameter rod. For a three piece rod, place the single rod size in the center position.







### **ATTACHING FINIALS**


There are two sizes of adapters included. For a three piece rod, there is only one size of adapters.



Extend rod to desired width. Lift rod with drapery and drop into brackets. Ensure to mount at least one bracket on each inner rod and outer rod to prevent rod movement when sliding curtain.

Adjust draperies to desired position.









Lock rods into position by tightening leveling screw by hand until finger tight. This will prevent the rod from moving.





Attach finials by pushing the end of the finial post into the end of the plastic insert until completely snug. Rotate finial on rod for proper alignment if required.






Extra adapters pack can be discarded.





#### **Hollow Slide-on Finial**


NOTE: If your finials are with a post, please see the reverse side of these instructions and use ADAPTER PACK (A).



Place brackets against wall at desired locations. Mark screw holes with pencil. Be sure marks are level across opening. Mount at least one bracket on each inner rod and outer rod to prevent rod movement when sliding curtain.








# ASSEMBLE ROD

Assemble the rod by inserting and sliding the smaller diameter rod into the larger diameter rod. For a three piece rod, place the single rod size in the center position.








## ATTACHING FINIALS

There are two sizes of finials included. For a three piece rod, there is only one size of finials.


Press corresponding finials onto each end of the rod until completely snug.



Extend rod to desired width. Lift rod with drapery and drop into brackets. Ensure to mount at least one bracket on each inner rod and outer rod to prevent rod movement when sliding curtain. Adjust draperies to desired position.



Lock rods into position by tightening leveling screw by hand until finger tight. This will prevent the rod from moving.
