- The device contains rotating parts. Never reach into the rotating cylinders during operation. You might injure yourself and damage the device.
- Route the cable to prevent people from tripping over it.
- Never expose the device to high temperatures (radiator, etc.) or weather impact (rain, etc.).

IMPORTANT PRECAUTIONS

- 1. NEVER immerse in water.
- 2. NEVER use near water.
- 3. NEVER use an abrasive sponge or cloth.
- 4. NEVER use a scouring pad on the appliance.
- 5. NEVER leave appliance unattended while in use.
- 6. Unplug unit from outlet when not in use and during cleaning.
- 7. Don't operate this appliance with a damaged cord or plug, nor if the appliance ever malfunctions.
- 8. Don't clean any parts of this appliance in a dishwasher.


Dangerous mains voltage! Faulty electrical installation or excessively high line. Voltage may cause electrical shock.

- 1. The device is exclusively suitable for 120 V~, 60Hz.
- 2. Do not operate the device when it shows visible damages or the power cord or power plug are effective.
- 3. Do not open the housing but leave any repair to professionals. Contact a specialty shop for this purpose. Liability and warranty claims are excluded in case of unauthorized repair, improper connection or incorrect operation.
- 4. When performing repairs, only parts matching the original device data may be used. This device contains electrical and mechanical parts absolutely required to protect against dangers.
- 5. Never submerge the device itself or the power cord or power plug in water.
- 6. Never touch the power plug with wet hands.
- 7. Keep the device, the power plug and the power cord away from open flames and hot surfaces.
- 8. Do not bend the cable and keep it away from sharp edges.
- 9. Use the device only in dry rooms indoors. Never operate it in wet rooms or in the rain.
- 10. Never leave the device unattended when in use!

Assembly

DESCRIPTION OF PARTS

- 1.Tower
- 2.Tiers
- 3.Auger
- 4.Bowl
- 5.Indicator Light
- 6.Control Knob
- 7.Base
- 8&9.Retaining pin



- 1.Put the Auger onto Retaining Pin 8
- 2.The tower 1 and tiers 2 are not detachable,put the tower onto bowel,part 10 is fixed on 9
- 3.Plug the power plug into a readily accessible outlet

This device is intended to let melted chocolate flow over the umbrellas to create a decorative fountain-like effect.

Other heat-resistant, pourable foods such as cheese orsauces can also be used instead of chocolate.

Before first use, clean the device by wiping with a moist, non-abrasive sponge, towel or cloth and then dry the device completely.

- 1. Use customary chocolate coating or special chocolate fountain chocolate from specialty stores since it is more pourable than conventional chocolate.
- 2. When using conventional chocolate, vegetable oil must be added to ensure ease of flowing. This chocolate fountain is designed for approximately 350 g melted chocolate coating.
- 3. Place the device on a heat resistant and level surface.
- 4. Put the Auger onto Retaining Pin 8.
- 5. The tower1 and tiers2 are not detachable, put the tower onto bowel, part 10 is fixed on 9.
- 6. Plug the power plug into a readily accessible outlet.
- 7. Set the ON/OFF switch 6 to position HEAT. The indicator lamp lights up. Preheat the device at least 15-20 Minutes prior to use.
- 8. Pour the melted chocolate coating into the filling trough. Do not overfill! Add some vegetable oil if the melted chocolate is too thick.
- 9. Set the ON/OFF switch 6 to position FLOW. The conveyor screw begins to move. The chocolate is transported upward through the cylinder and flows down over the umbrellas into the filling trough.
- 10. Dip foods with skewers into the melted chocolate.
- 11. You can dip different fruits. Depending on the season and your preference, into the melted chocolate. You can also dip biscuits, marshmallows or the like.
- 12. Use long wooden skewers or the like for dipping the foods.
- 13. After using the device, set the ON/OFF switch to position OFF.
- 14. Clean the device immediately and pour out excess chocolate

CLEANING & MAINTENANCE

Aggressive of solvent-based cleaning agents (e.g. gasoline, thinner, etc.) attack the surface.

- 1. Never use aggressive or solvent-based cleaning agents.
- 2. Pour the access chocolate into a bowl while it is still liquid. You can save it for the next use. Observe also the expiration dates on the chocolate coating package.
- 3. Wipe the housing with a damp cloth and then dry it thoroughly. No liquid may enter into the device.
- 4. Wipe the filling trough with a moist cloth or a soft sponge. Use a mild detergent if necessary. Carefully remove all chocolate residues.
- 5. Clean the individual attachments immediately after use. The cylinder with the umbrellas, the conveyor screw and the holder are dishwasher-safe.

Hard to wash after using	Not remove the tower and the auger before chocolate solidified	Unplug the unit from the wall outlet and allow it to cool.Before the choc- olate solidifies, remove the Tower and the Auger and wash in warm soapy water
The warping of the Auger,Tower or Tiers	Chocolate temperature is too high	Do not heat chocolate over 110oF (45oC),it will make the auger,tower or tiers warped
