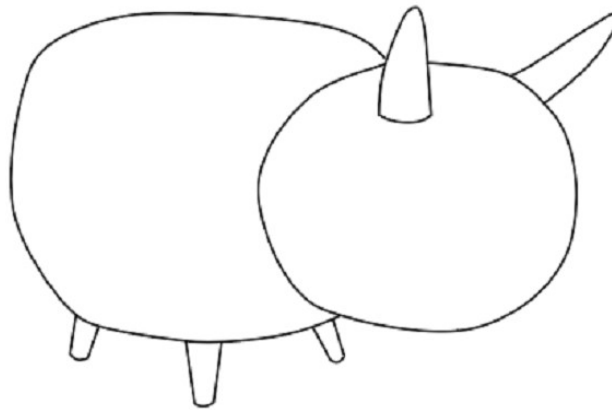
Caution : You must read this before you proceed

Ottoman

Warning: Keep away from children under 36 months as fibers may shed causing a choking hazard.






CAUTION: Faux fur can become separated from the backing. The loose strands can wrap tightly around an appendage, such as a child's finger or toe, and pose a potential risk for injury including loss of the appendage.

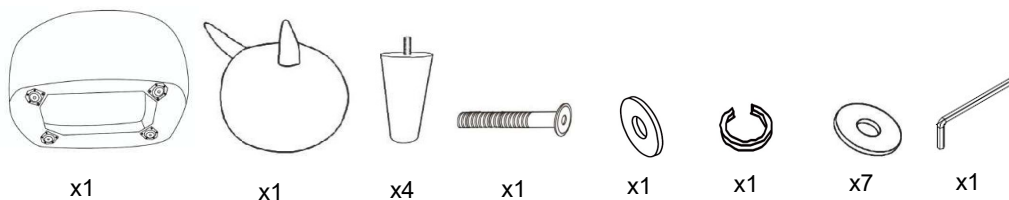

A	A line drawing of the Ottoman Body part, which is a rounded rectangle with four small circular attachment points at the corners.	Ottoman Body	1
B	A line drawing of the Ottoman Head part, which is a circle with a small pointed horn on top and two pointed ears on the sides.	Ottoman Head	1
C	A line drawing of a single Wooden Leg part, which is a tapered cylinder with a small hole at the top.	Wooden Leg	4

Assembly Preparation

Before Beginning Assembly:



- Read instructions, cover to cover-



- Have 2 adults on hand for assembly-



- Do not assemble on flooring or carpet-



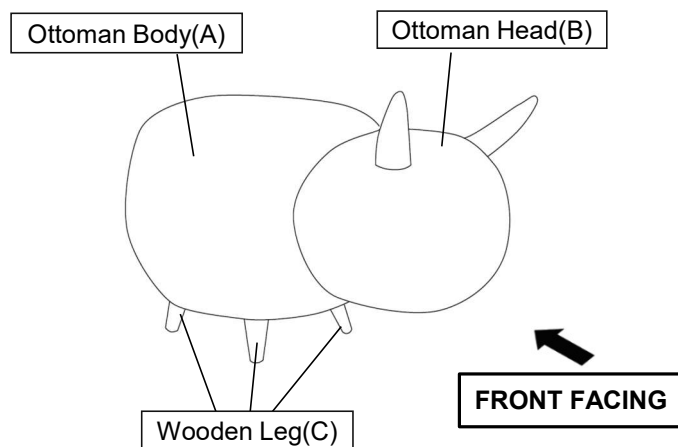
- Assemble on a clean non-marring surface (packing foam)-



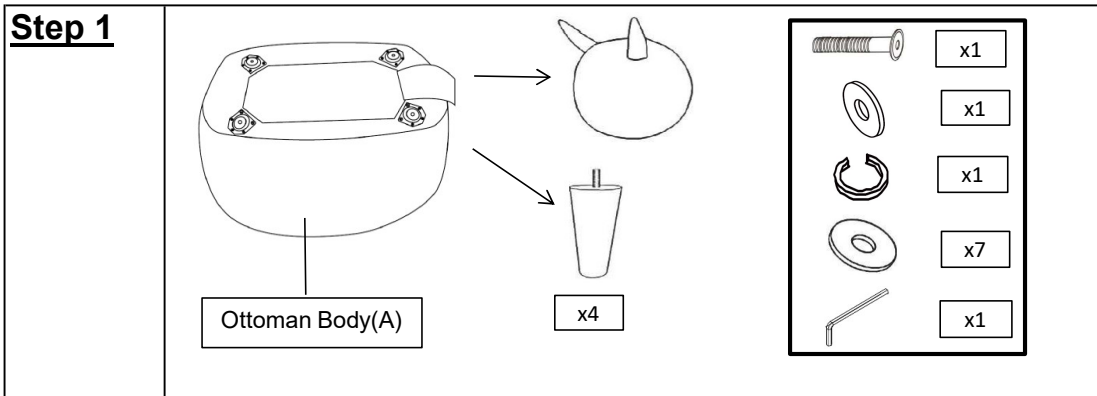
- Save all packaging until finished-

Assembly Steps

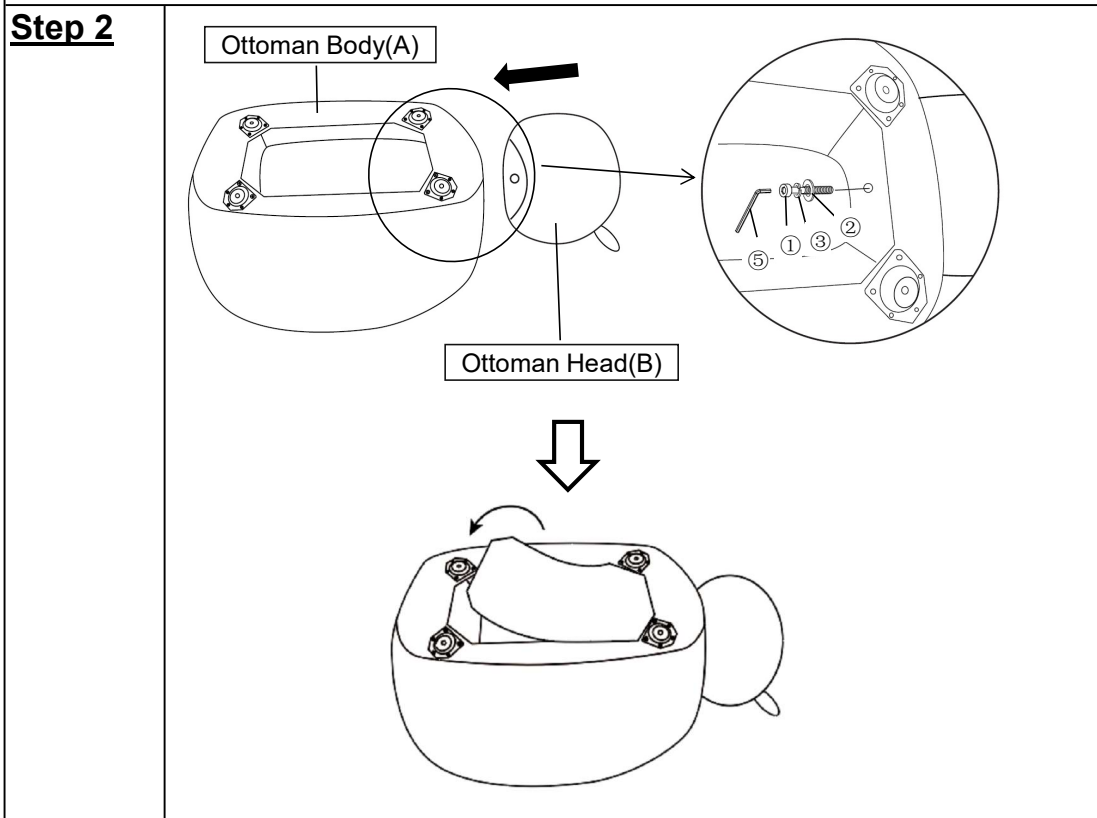
Overview



This Ottoman has multiple parts and may require up to 30 minutes to assemble. To give you an overview of the Ottoman parts, the above picture is to help you put the various parts into perspective. Please read through the instructions below to familiarise yourself with the parts and steps before assembly.

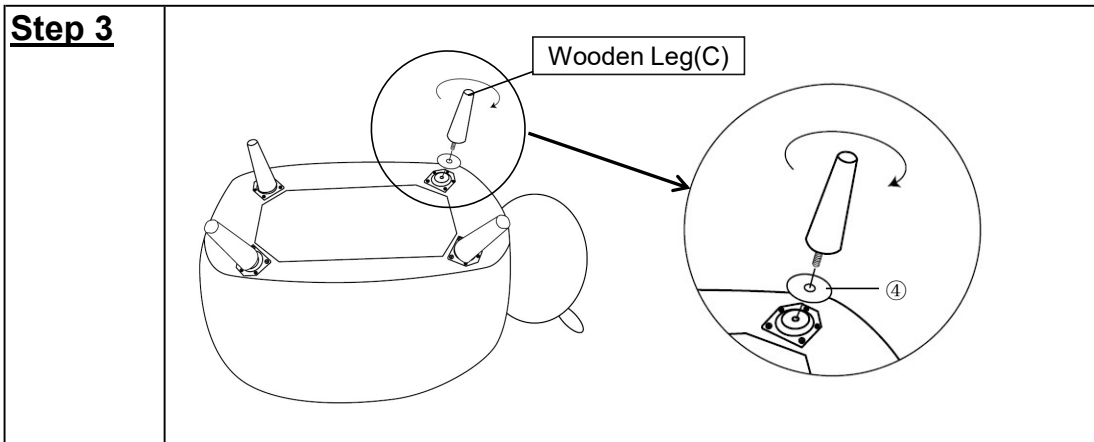


Carefully remove the dust cover from the bottom of the Ottoman Body(A) and remove the Ottoman Head(B), Wooden Legs(C) and Hardware, and place them on a clean, non-marring surface.



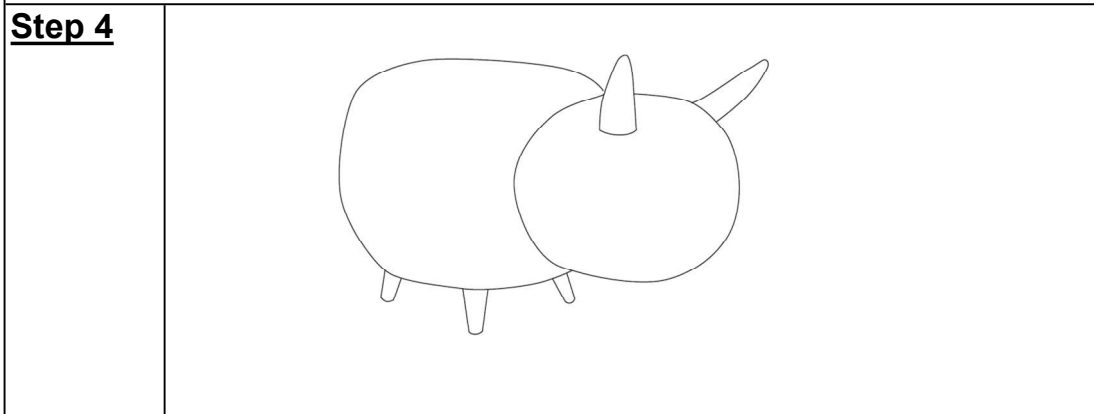
Align the Ottoman Head(B) to Ottoman Body(A). Attach the Ottoman Head(B) to Ottoman Body(A) using Bolts(①), Spring Washers(③) and Washers(②) with Allen Wrench(⑤), as shown in the picture above, then ,stick magic tape back.

Note: When attaching the Ottoman Head the horns should face down.














Position the Ottoman on it's side.
 Install the Wooden Legs(C) into the bottom of the Ottoman Body(A) by placing a Gasket(④) onto the threaded stem of the Legs. And then insert the threaded stem into the threaded mounting position at each Corner of the Bottom of the Ottoman Body(A). Tighten by turning the Legs clockwise.

Position Ottoman right side up and test for stability on a Level Surface.
 Note: The use of Gaskets are OPTIONAL and are especially useful to help alleviate slight wobbles. Some Wooden Legs may need more than one whilst some legs do not need any.



Your Ottoman is ready for use.
 Your Ottoman can only be used on a flat, level surface.

Care & Maintenance

- ✓  • Furniture may scratch floors. We recommend using furniture pads to protect your floors.
- ⊘  • Do not put hot items directly on furniture surface.
- ⊘  • Do not clean furniture with harsh cleansers or polish.
- ⊘  • Do not place furniture under direct sunlight.
- ⊘  • Do not place furniture near heating or cooling vents.
- ⊘  • Do not write on furniture without a padded barrier to protect the surface.
- ⊘  • Do not place furniture outside . For indoor use only.
- ⊘  • Not for commercial use. For residential use only.
- ⊘  • Stains may be removed with mild soap solution and damp cloth.
- ⊘  • Children should not climb or jump on the furniture.
- ✓  • Dust and pick-up spills using a clean, non-colored, lint-free cloth.
